

RESOLUTION NUMBER R22-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAFFORD, GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA, REGARDING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) AIRPORT RESCUE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE.


WHEREAS, the City submitted to the FAA an American Rescue Plan Act Airport Grant Application on November 16, 2021 for Federal Funds to be reimbursed up to \$32,000; and,

WHEREAS, the funding would be eligible for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitization, janitorial services, combating the spread of pathogens at the airport, and debt service payments; and,

WHEREAS, if awarded, Airport Rescue Grants may be used to reimburse airport operational expenses directly related to Safford Regional Airport incurred no earlier than January 20, 2020 and debt service payments occurring on or after March 11, 2021.


